The Air Accident Investigation Department (AAID) is an independent government agency mandated by Minister for Tourism and Aviation with investigating every civil aviation accident and incidents in the Bahamas. We determine the probable cause of the accidents and issue safety recommendations aimed at preventing future accidents.

On August 27, 2018, the AAID adopted its safety recommendation report. The details of a related accident investigation and the resulting safety recommendations may be found in the attached report.

Among the Safety Recommendations are eight of critical importance, five issued to the Safety Oversight Department and three issued to the Aviation Security Department, which can be found in two separate attached reports.

The AAID is vitally interested in these recommendation because they are designed to prevent accidents and save lives. We would appreciate a response from your organization within 90 days detailing the actions you have taken or intend to take to implement them. When replying please refer to the safety recommendations by number.
